## 2026 CCD Pollinator Yard Sign Program

The Cody Conservation District is seeking participants for our Pollinator Yard Sign Program. Local gardens meeting a set criterion will receive a yard sign designating them “Certified Pollinator Habitat.” Signs feature a full color display of a native butterfly and the Cody Conservation District logo.

### Desired Qualifications for Pollinator Gardens:

- Located in the town of Cody and visible to the public.
- Contains a minimum of 9 flowering plants (*including trees, shrubs, and forbs*)
  - A minimum of 4 flowering plant species must be native to Cody
  - A minimum of 3 species must be actively blooming during each season (except winter)
- No use of broad-spectrum herbicides and pesticides. Targeted applications of pesticides and herbicides are permitted.
- Provides a clean, shallow water source for pollinating insects.

### Additional Considerations:

- Limit the number of hybridized flowers (*scent, pollen, and nectar are often bred out in favor of multiple blooms and are therefore of little to no benefit to pollinators*)
- Provide Bee Habitat:
  - Ground nesting bees require undisturbed light textured soils; preferably on a eastern or southeastern aspect.
  - If using a “bee hotel” clean and re-drill holes annually to mitigate the spread of disease.

Each garden will be listed on an interactive map on our website. Signs will be distributed beginning in May, and they will be collected in the fall. The Cody Conservation District can assist with plant selection and best management practices. If you’re in need of inspiration, please visit our pollinator garden located on the south side of the Park County Complex next to the UW Extension Vegetable Garden.
